Keith W. gave the Treasurer's Report (see attached). The agency that provided the heating system has not been contacted. Eversource bill for Jan was \$363.75 (Rec'd. reading) and February's bill was \$277.00 (for Jan.)

The Town Band Stand has been covered by the CRA's insurance. Steve has had it deleted from our policy and the savings will be \$248.00 annually.

The donation box yielded \$122.00 recently.  
The Annual Meeting will take place on April 10<sup>th</sup>. Eight board members will be elected. A new Historian position needs to be filled. Four positions change annual. Mark W. & Linda O.'s positions expire - 2018. Refreshments will be served also.

Steve has been in contact with Lane Malcolm. Lane is willing to see

The gasoline Railway Express Agency sign  
that was originally from Gascoyne and  
had long been above the Depot front  
door is also for sale for \$300.00

Jake M. recently met with Jerry Flander  
regarding items of interest that were  
in the Switch house (hand tools, sign  
lanterns, paper items, etc.) He plans to  
meet with Jerry again and give us an  
update regarding items with local history.

Charles D. reported on the Tur de  
Chasck model railroad. He will  
speak with the director to see if this  
could be part of our May Train Show  
that will go on at Hopkinton High School.

Keith W. gave us a Train Show update.  
3 vendors, 9 tables are scheduled so  
far. He plans to leave flyers (hand out  
at the Depot and post info. locally).  
Keith also mentioned that perhaps a  
high school class could also sell some  
items on that date as a class fund  
raiser.

Brian has been working on  
obtaining more information and estimates  
regarding insulating yet unfinished

areas about the Depot (eves, basement, etc.) Steve will contact Ted Tracy to see if his maple sugar items could be sold to celebrate W.H. Maple season and also raise funds for the Depot.

Conrad Young's books will also be sold here (\$20.00).

Fred N. has been working on disconnecting the signal mast so necessary repair can take place soon.

T.D.3. Railroad "Skanty" update: A meeting to discuss how, when, and what's needed to move the building from its present location in the T.D.3. parking lot to near the Depot will take place on March 27<sup>th</sup>. Brian hopes to meet with John Herck to see if he could be of help for the moving process.

Building Committee: Jake M. plans to paint, fix the Contoocook signs on the east end of the Depot, etc. - weather permitting.

Events committee: Mark, Linda, & Keith are working on the upcoming model train show.

Coach Committee: Fred N. will resume working on the Pullman Friends and all weather permitting. Staging for early
